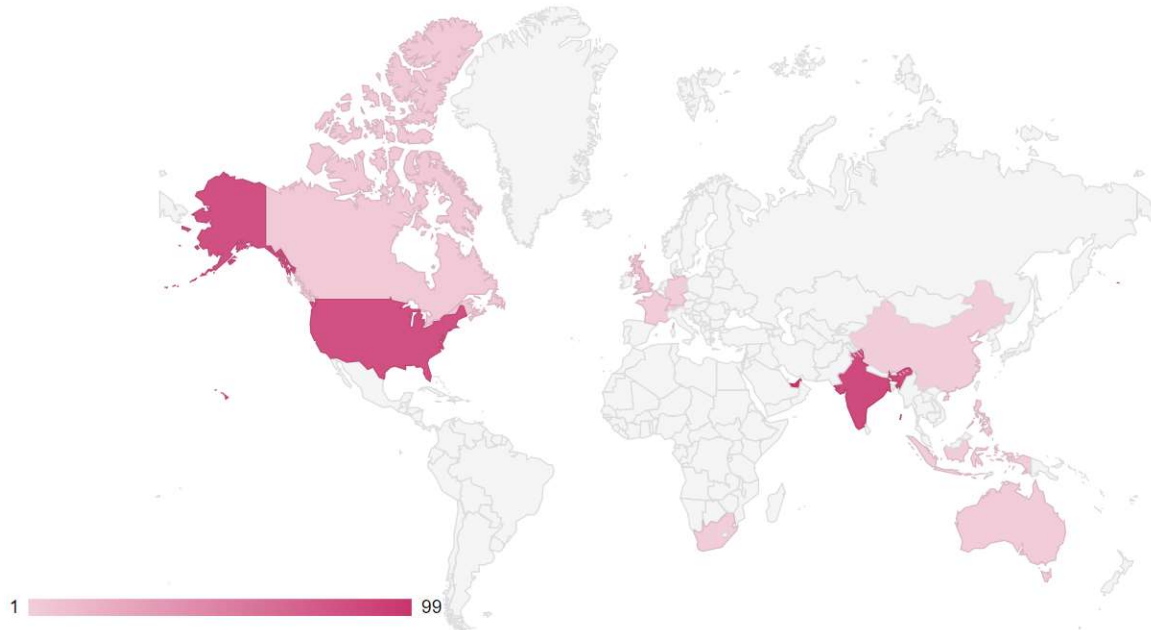

Little Heroes

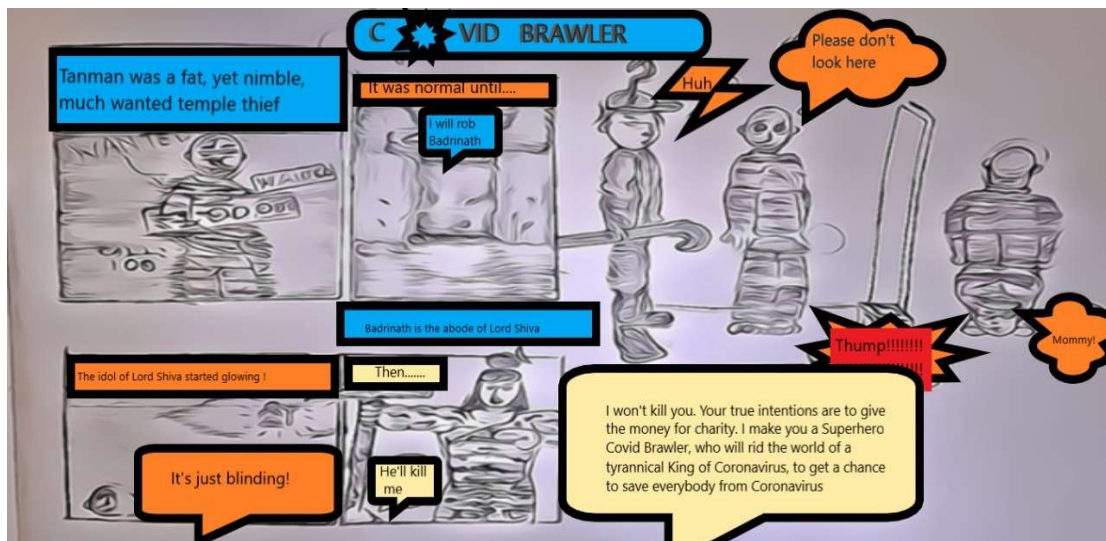


Ryan Hickman

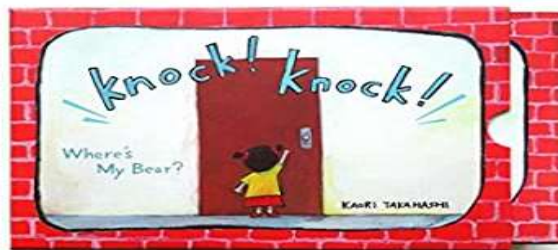

Goldfish can remember an obstacle course a month later.

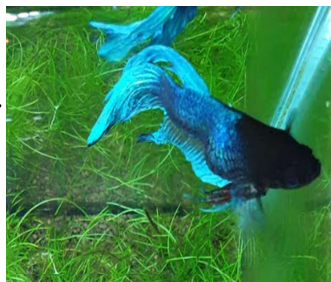
Fish Feel Pain.

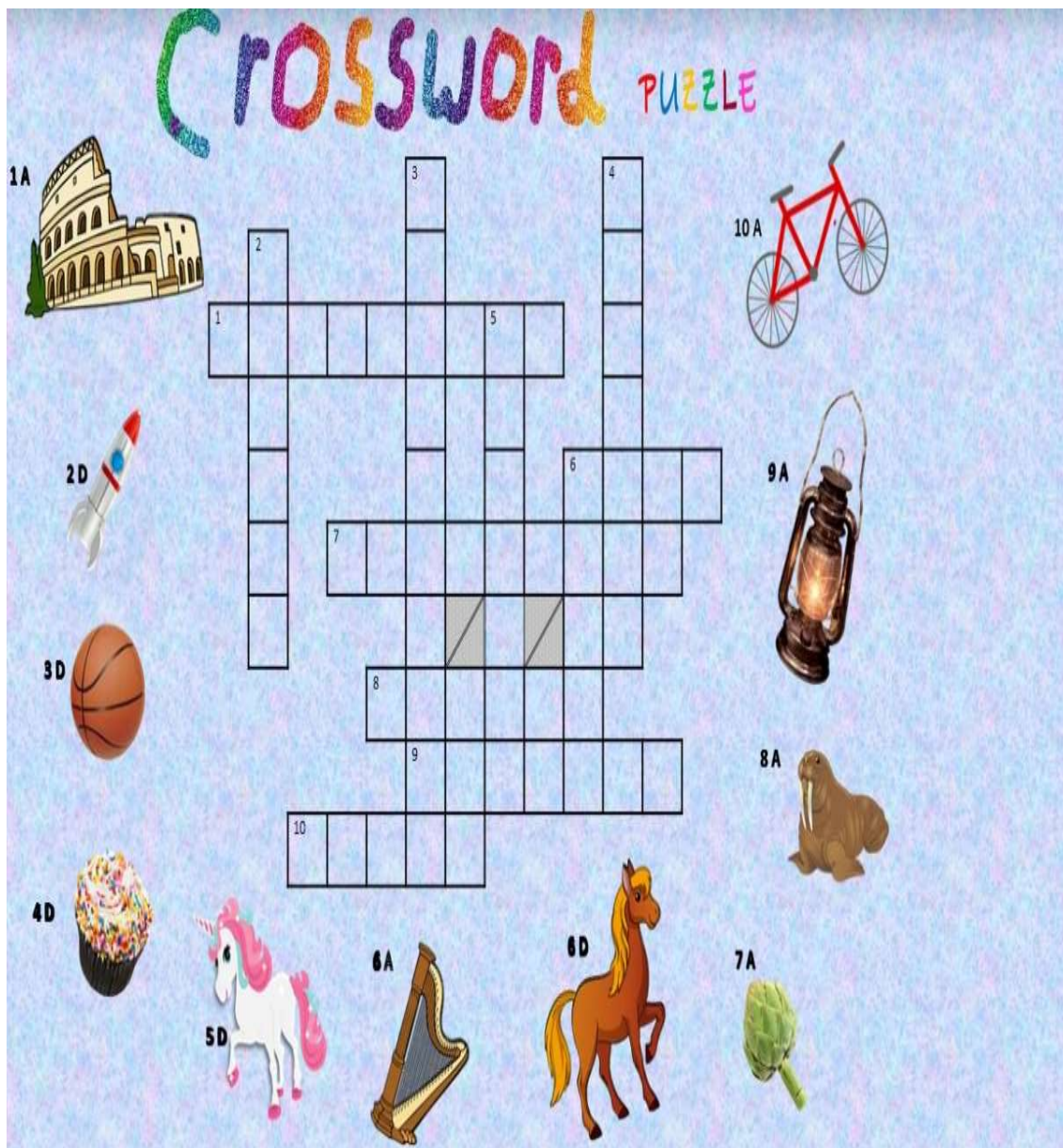

Premier League

Matchday 34 Round-Up

Things are starting to get really interesting in the English Premier League, with matches that could affect both ends of the table being played. All teams tried their hardest, with 4 games remaining. Things started off in England with the first game of Round 34 being played between 18th placed Watford and 20th placed Norwich. It was a crucial match for both teams to escape the bottom 3 of the table, which would avoid relegation to the second division.

After going in front in the 4th minute, Watford turned the game around to won 2-1 to climb up to 17th place, leaving Norwich City with very little hope to climb up the ladder. Next came what was a thriller of a match. 14th placed Crystal Palace faced a challenge against 4th placed Chelsea. Within 27 minutes, Chelsea had gone up by 2 goals and looked the clear favourites for the win. But Palace scored a goal in the 34th minute and scored another later in the second half. However, Chelsea scored a minute before Palace's second, securing a win for the Blues.

Chelsea moved up to 3rd, sitting on 60 points. Arsenal were to play Leicester City, with Leicester looking to regain their position in 3rd place, stolen by Chelsea. Arsenal got themselves a lead within 20 minutes, and were defending solidly. But just as it looked like a win for the Gunners, their striker was given a red card and they conceded a late goal to tie 1-1 with the Foxes. The result wasn't positive for Leicester, because they remained in 4th place.

Burnley prevailed 1-0 over West Ham in a mid-table clash, which was followed by Newcastle United getting thrashed 5-0 by 2nd placed Manchester City. 6th placed Wolverhampton succumbed to 7th placed Sheffield United, which closed the gap between the two. Newly crowned Premier League champions Liverpool cruised past 15th placed Brighton 3-1, to bring their point total to an astonishing 92. A game between 11th placed Everton and 12th placed Southampton ended all square in a 1-1 draw, and 9th placed Tottenham failed to win against 18th placed Bournemouth. The final match of Round 34 was played on Friday morning, between 19th ranked Aston Villa and 5th placed Manchester United. United continued their 11-game unbeaten streak in the league with a 3-0 victory against Villa.

Between the 10 games played, 5 records were made, equalled and broken. Manchester City became the first team in history to have 5 players that have 10 or more goals in one season, and Liverpool broke a record to have the highest point total after 34 games. The other 3 records were all related to Manchester United. Manchester United broke the record for the most penalties awarded in a single season, and became the first team in history to win 4 consecutive wins by a 3-goal margin. United's goalkeeper, David De Gea, became the foreign player with the most games played for Manchester United.

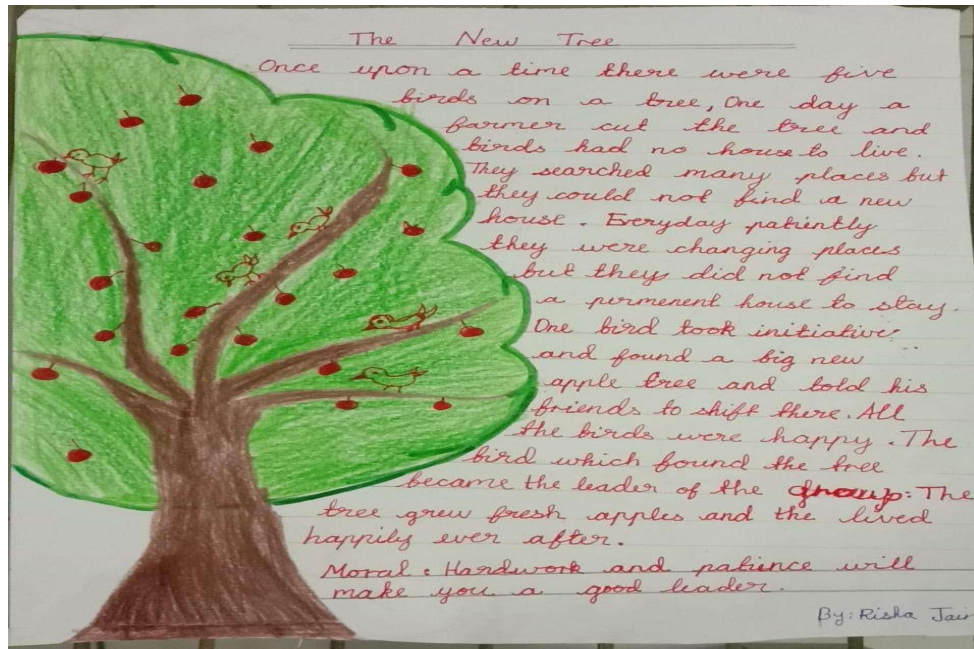

INGREDIENTS

- 200 grams chocolate cupcakes
- 1 bar white chocolate
- 1 bar dark chocolate

PROCEDURE

- 01** Take chocolate cupcakes and crush them crumbly. Add creaming and 10 cup milk gradually mix and get dough consistency and add the nuts and keep in refrigerator for 30 mins.

- 03** After 30 mins take out the cake pop dough and roll it in to smaller balls then coat using the chocolate paste and once again keep it in the refrigerator for 10 mins.

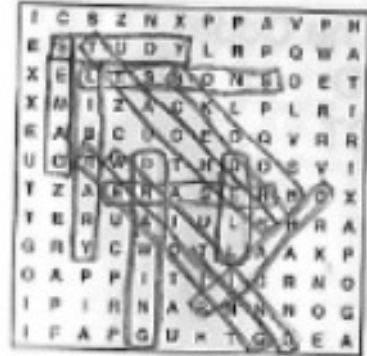
